Jodi Friedman says, "our number one goal was to close the achievement gap and for ten years we did this just by focusing on academics. We realized that that is not enough. We needed to re-think our curriculum and re-think the culture of our school to be culturally responsive and actively antiracist." Why do you think she emphasizes the essential nature of having a school culture that is "actively antiracist"?
